



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT NON-CDL C WRITTEN AND ROAD TESTS

### HOW TO GET YOUR NON-CDL C PERMIT

#### WHAT MUST I STUDY TO PASS THE NON-CDL C WRITTEN TEST?

Study the following sections of the New York State Commercial Driver's Manual\*:

- Section 1 Introduction
- Section 2 Driving Safely
- Section 3 Transporting Cargo Safely

\***NOTE:** Although this manual refers to Commercial Driver Licenses (CDL), the general driving principles discussed in the manual apply to both CDL and Non-CDL C licenses.

#### WHAT KIND OF TEST MUST I PASS TO GET A NON-CDL C PERMIT?

You must pass a 20-question multiple-choice Non-CDL C permit test. You may take the 20-question test in any Motor Vehicles office that offers CDL written tests.

### HOW TO GET YOUR NON-CDL C LICENSE

#### WHAT KIND OF TEST MUST I PASS TO GET A NON-CDL C LICENSE?

Once you receive your Non-CDL C permit, to get your Non-CDL C license you must pay a \$40 road test fee, and schedule, take and pass a road test\*\* in a Non-CDL C vehicle. You may schedule the road test by phone at 518-402-2100, or through the Internet on the NYS DMV web site at [www.nysdmv.com/roadtest/default.html](http://www.nysdmv.com/roadtest/default.html).

\*\***NOTE:** The Non-CDL C road test is the same as the CDL road test.

### AVAILABLE ENDORSEMENTS

A Non-CDL C license does not require you to have CDL endorsements. However, once you pass the 20-question Non-CDL C permit test, you may obtain any of the following endorsements.

#### ENDORSEMENTS

#### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- You must pass the Tow Truck endorsement test.
- You must pass the CDL HAZMAT sub-test.
- You must pass the CDL combination vehicle written test and road test in a Class A vehicle.
- You must pass the road test in a Class B vehicle.

**NOTE:** A Non-CDL C license is not subject to Air Brake restrictions. You do not have to pass the Air Brakes written test, even if the Non-CDL C vehicle you drive has air brakes.
